Benefits of the Grant

A grant allows the use of a piano from PSF's fleet for a limited time.

- The term of the grant is for a minimum of one year. After the initial year, up to four six-month extensions can be granted by the PSF Scholarship Committee. An organization receiving a grant and extensions can have the use of a piano for a maximum of three years.
- A contract that covers the legal, insurance, and ownership details must be signed after the grant is awarded and before the piano is delivered to the Recipient.

Expectations of Grant Recipients

- The Recipient must not discriminate on the basis of age, race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, or disability.
- The Recipient will offer music education, music therapy, or other music-related programs.
- The Recipient actively works to support children of low-income or underserved populations in the Portland metro area.
- The Recipient must not use the PSF piano directly to generate profit.
- The Recipient must maintain a logbook describing the type and amount of use of the piano.
- The Recipient must send a report to PSF every six months addressing the piano's condition, use and benefit.
- Insurance, maintenance and liability are covered in the actual Piano Placement Grant contract.
